Title: How AI Could Replace Human Podcasters

Synopsis:

Discussion Questions

Use these questions to spark conversation and reflection in the classroom:

- What are some of the challenges and benefits of using AI-generated content in podcasts? Consider aspects like efficiency, creativity, and emotional authenticity.
- What does the "uncanny valley" mean in the context of Al-generated podcasts, and how does it affect the listener experience? Do you think an Al-hosted podcast could be as engaging as a human-hosted one? Why or why not?
- If Alchemy were to feature only AI bots in the future, what would be lost from the show's current format? Who do you think should decide the topics for an AI podcast: the AI itself, or the creators? Why?
- How might the rise of AI podcasts influence the future of human creativity and storytelling? As writers, how could you use the concept of AI replacing humans in your fiction to explore larger themes like identity, technology, or loss?

Writer's Prompts

Creative exercises to help students apply the themes of the topic:

- Prompt 1: The AI Protagonist. Write a short story from the perspective of an AI podcast host
 who begins questioning its role in the world. Does it want to break free from its
 programming, or is it content being "just a bot"?
- **Prompt 2:** When Humans Are Replaced. Imagine a world where human interaction is increasingly replaced by AI in everyday life. Write a scene where a character discovers that their closest friend has been replaced by an AI, and they struggle with whether or not to tell the difference.
- **Prompt 3:** Sock Drawer Disaster. Write a scene where an AI podcast bot tries to give advice on something mundane (like organizing a sock drawer) but gets it hilariously wrong, leading to total chaos in the character's life.

• **Prompt 4:** The Fake Recipe. Write a monologue or podcast-style dialogue between two Al bots who have to "improvise" a famous recipe (like mac and cheese) but, as Al often do, get all the details hilariously wrong. The recipe ends up being nothing like what was intended.

Class Activities

These activities will help expand on the themes of the topic:

- **Group Discussion:** Break into small groups and discuss the rise of AI in creative fields like podcasting, writing, and music. Debate whether or not you think AI can ever truly replace human creativity, or if it's merely a tool that enhances it.
- **Design Exercise:** Design your own AI podcast. What would the AI host sound like? What topics would it cover? Would it have the same structure as a traditional podcast, or would it be more chaotic? Try to give your AI podcast a unique "voice" that feels distinct from human hosts.
- Debate: Have a class debate where half the class argues for the benefits of AI in podcasting (efficiency, objectivity, consistency), and the other half argues for the irreplaceable value of human hosts (emotion, connection, creativity). Afterward, switch sides and argue the opposite.
- Collaborative Story-Building: In groups, collaborate on a short story where AI takes over
 the role of a traditional human job whether it's podcasting, teaching, or even writing.

 Explore how this shift in power affects the characters involved. Does AI become too
 powerful, or is it a welcome change? Discuss the potential consequences of these
 advancements.
